B.1. GERMANY

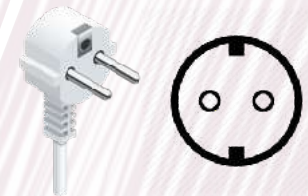

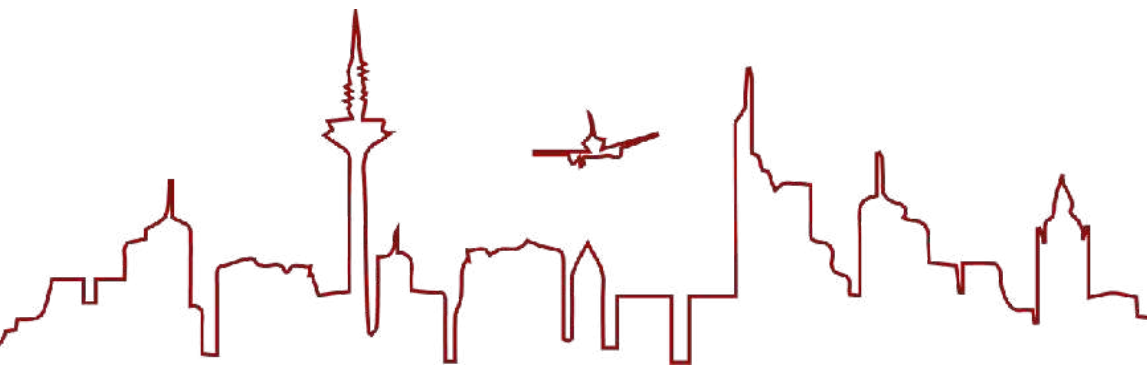


B. HOST COUNTRY

Things to know before visiting Germany

- Opening hours** Everywhere in Germany, supermarkets, pharmacies and shops are closed on Sundays. Make sure you have everything you need before Sunday rolls in. Restaurants and cafés however are normally open the whole weekend.
- Electricity** The power plugs and sockets are of type F.
The standard voltage is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.
- Currency** As in many other European countries, the Euro (€) is the currency. Whereas cash is always accepted, not every restaurant or supermarket accepts debit cards or credit cards. Be sure to check beforehand!
- Bottle deposit** In Germany, we use a bottle return system. When you purchase certain products, a deposit (*Pfand*) is paid alongside for the bottle. When you return the empty bottle, you will get your deposit back. This encourages people to return their empty bottles. The empty bottles are then reused or recycled.

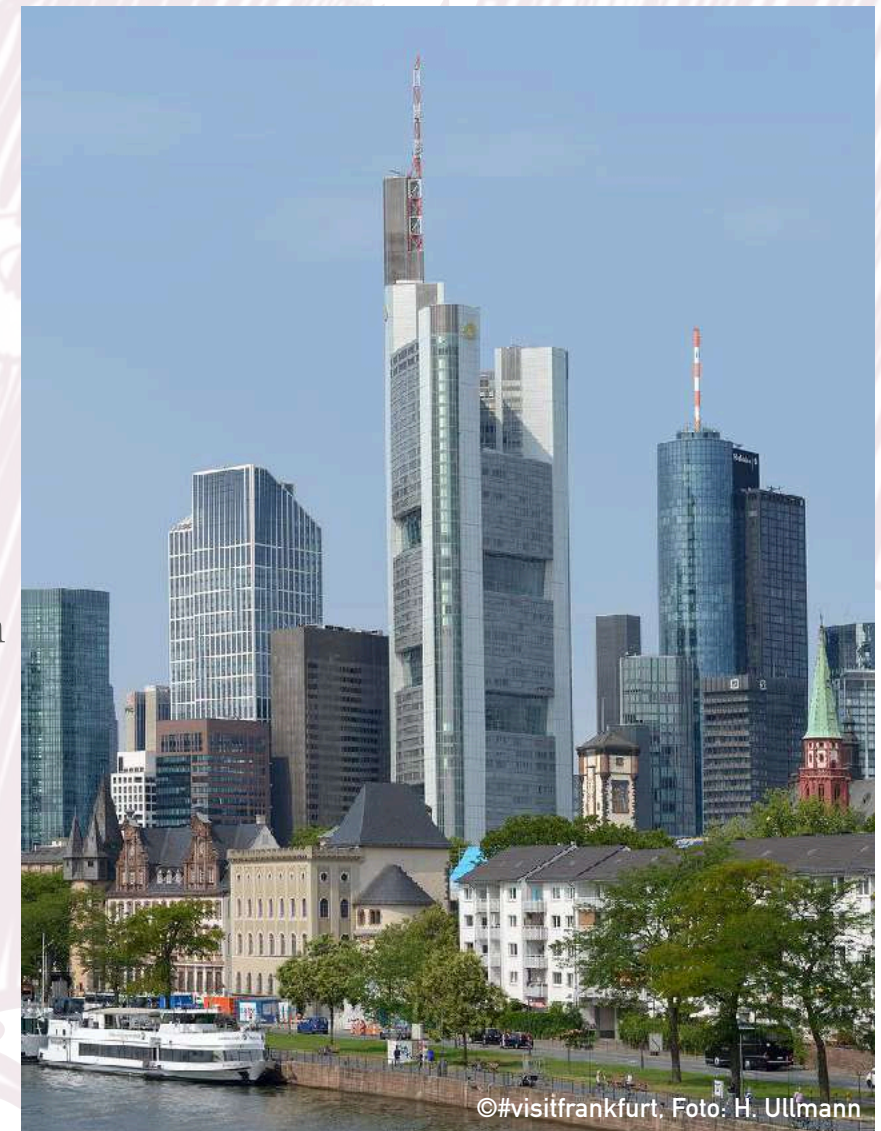

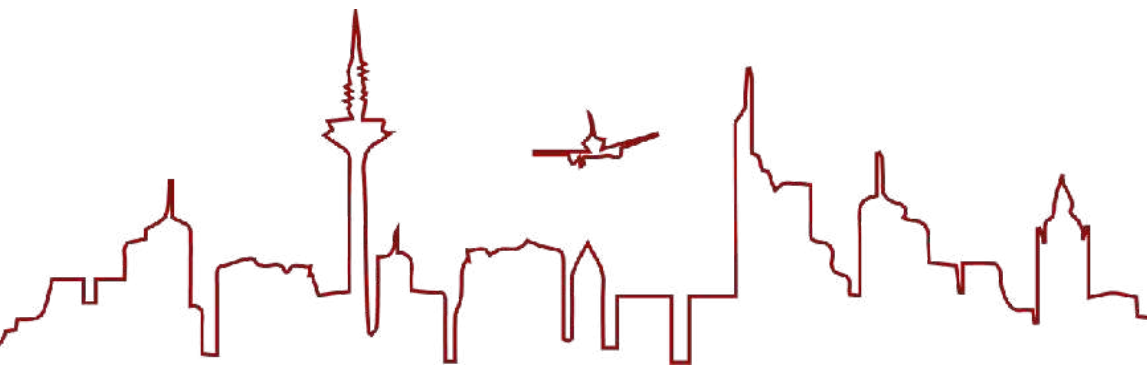

B.2. FRANKFURT AM MAIN

The dynamic and international financial and trade fair city with multiple possibilities, Frankfurt am Main provides big city atmosphere due to its unique and imposing skyline and variety of activities such as museums, sport events, bars and clubs. The Zeil, Frankfurt's premier pedestrian promenade, ranks amongst Germany's most profitable shopping streets and one of the biggest in Europe. To indicate the historical importance of Frankfurt in German history, there are many places all over the city to discover such as the new old town – The *Dom/Römer* Quarter, the *Kaiserdom* and the *Museumsufer*.

Almost one in three of the people living in Frankfurt do not hold a German passport. No matter where visitors come from, they will always meet people in Frankfurt who speak their language and a restaurant that serves their favourite food. The open and hospitable atmosphere in Frankfurt originates from its centuries-old role as a trading centre. This liberal and democratic tradition of the city may be one reason for the fact that people from very diverse cultures have lived here in peace with one another for a long time. They have all played a role in making this city shine slightly differently from every angle, like a jewel shines slightly differently when you look at it from different sides.



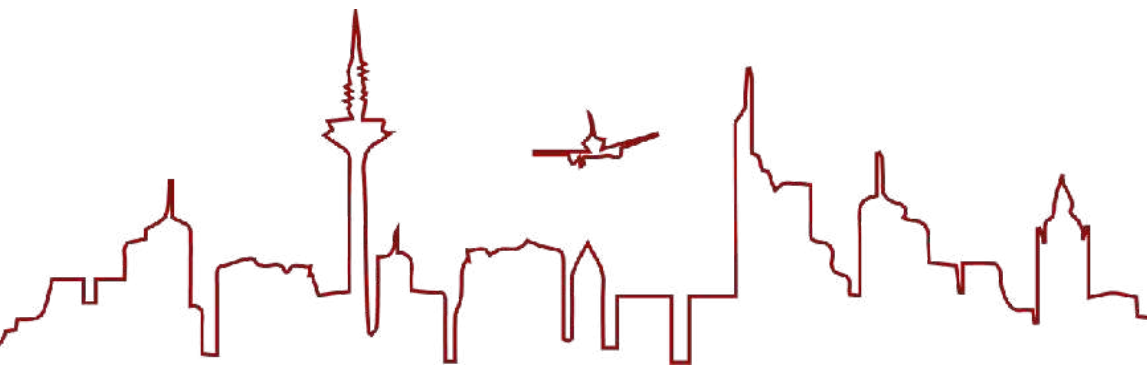


B. HOST COUNTRY



Because of the central location of Frankfurt am Main in Germany and Europe, it became an important traffic hub and attracts many visitors each year. However, the history and tradition are still present. People are able to taste Frankfurt's *Grüne Soße* and *Apfelwein* which are famous beyond its borders. Regional products and international specialties indicate Frankfurt's culinary aspect.

Besides, Frankfurt am Main has a wide variety of different sports activities, from mass sport to professionals. The IRONMAN European championship, Mainova Frankfurt Marathon and the J.P. Morgan Corporate Challenge are just a few to be mentioned. Moreover, soccer plays an important role in Frankfurt with its most famous football club *Eintracht Frankfurt*. Their games attract more than 50,000 people on average to visit the stadium. In general, Frankfurt's population has traditionally a great affinity to sports.

Vovinam Viet Vo Dao came to Germany in the late 1970s. Vietnamese Vovinam coaches and masters came to Germany as boat people and for professional reasons. They set up the first Vovinam clubs in their new home, e.g. in Stuttgart, Frankfurt and Munich. The German Vovinam Federation (*Deutscher Vovinam Viet Vo Dao Fachverband* - DVVF) was founded on 28 March, 2010 in Frankfurt. Founding members were 6 Vovinam Clubs with 4 masters.

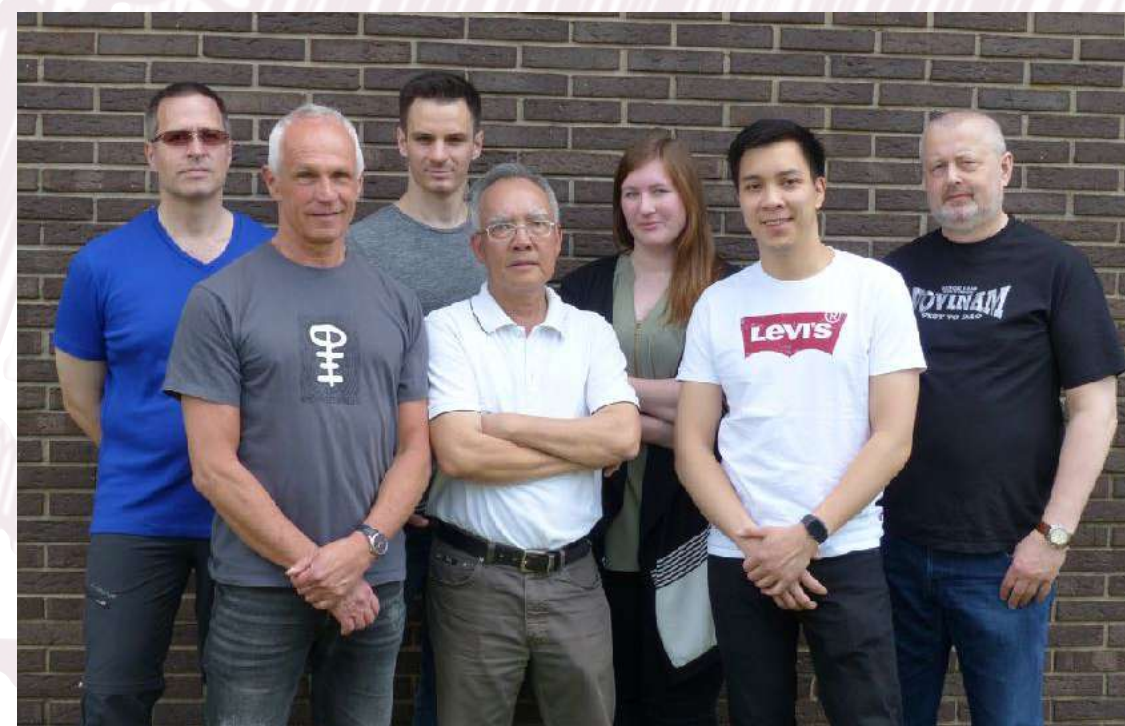

C. THE VENUE

Today the German Vovinam Viet Vo Dao Federation (DVVF) consists of 10 clubs with 5 masters. The most experienced Master and Vice President of the federation is Vo Su Tran Dai Chieu (6th Dang), who has already organised an International Children's Championship in Frankfurt in 2001. The DVVF is one of the founder members of the EVVF and have hosted several international events, for example the EVVF Seminar in Frankfurt, the Oktoberfest Seminars in Munich or the Giỗ Tổ-Commemoration in Ronneburg.

On a national level, the Federation strives to balance the interests of competitiveness with the traditional aspects of Vovinam, as can be seen from the tasks of the Vice-Presidents. Thus, every year a championship and the Giỗ Tổ-Commemoration take place, which always attracts large numbers of participants.

C.2. THE HOST



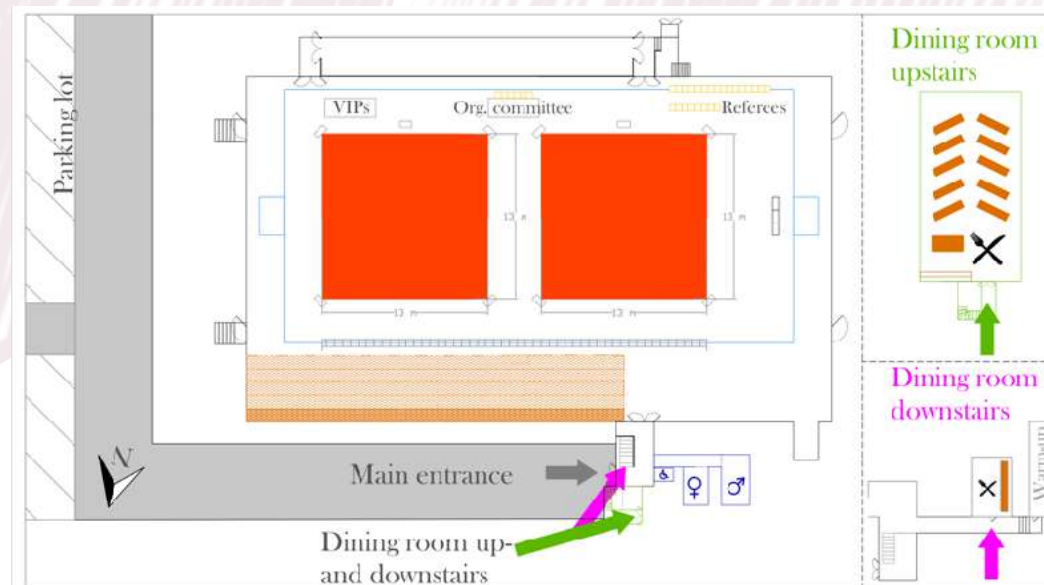
Frankfurt am Main is a significant site to Vovinam. Three German Vovinam clubs are located here in this city, one of which exists for over 30 years. Master Tran Dai Chieu opened his first class here in October 1986.

This club - SG 1877 Frankfurt-Nied e.V. - is one of the oldest sports clubs in the city of sports (*Sportstadt*) Frankfurt and the host to many national and international Vovinam events such as the Children championships in 2001 and 2004 and the EVVF seminar in 2016. This training site has been the home of many German competitors in the past and thus, is the perfect venue for successful young athletes of the future.

The floor plan of the sports centre (named: *Niddahalle*) comprises two competition areas (in orange). The main stand offers approx. 200 seats and is accessible through the main entrance. Competitors are able to warm up in the Dojo downstairs. The facility offers a wide range of changing and bath rooms for the competitors, as well as restrooms for the audience.

By car:



The recommended speed limit on motorways in Germany is 130 km/h.

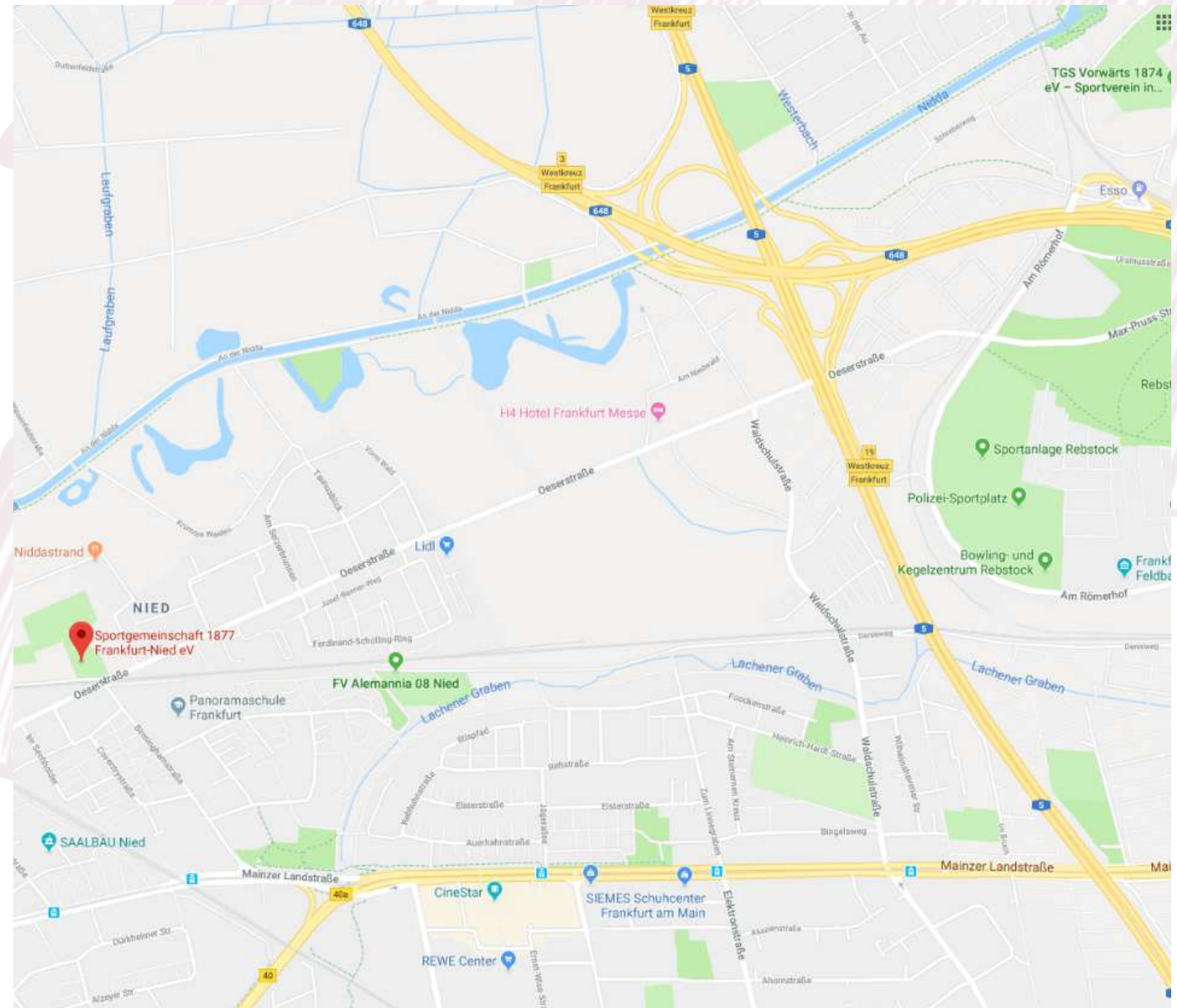
A large parking lot is in front of the sports centre.

From the North:

On motorway A5 Kassel/Würzburg: Take exit no. 19 *Westkreuz-Frankfurt*, stay on right lane to motorway A648 *Frankfurt-Stadtmitte*. Take the next exit Ursinusstraße. Turn left, then right and stay straight until you reach *Niddahalle*.

From the South:

On motorway A5 Würzburg/Kassel: Take exit no. 19 *Westkreuz-Frankfurt*, stay on right lane to motorway A648 *Frankfurt-Stadtmitte*. Take the next exit Ursinusstraße. Turn left, then right and stay straight until you reach *Niddahalle*.





C. THE VENUE

By plane:



The international Frankfurt am Main Airport (IATA-Code: FRA) is one of the busiest airports in Europe and can therefore be reached from every hub around the world.

Furthermore, one has the possibility to fly to Frankfurt-Hahn (IATA-Code: HHN). Despite the resemblance by name, this airport is about 116 kilometers away from Frankfurt Nied. Low cost carriers operate at this airport with lots of connections to the centre of Frankfurt. From there, you may catch a bus to the international airport or to the city centre of Frankfurt (1 hour ride for an additional fee). There are several companies providing this shuttle service such as *Flixbus* or *Flibco*.

Shuttle service:



The sports centre is located in Frankfurt Nied, which is quite close to the international airport of Frankfurt FRA. Moreover, the hotels are also in the vicinity of the sports centre. If required, the Organising Committee will assist you with a shuttle service for both the airport, as well as the hotel ↔ sports centre transfer. The cost for the transportation is 30 € per person and includes both the round trips to the airports and the daily shuttles between the hotel and the sports centre. Please bear in mind that we might put smaller groups together for a more eco-friendly planning. **If you wish to use our Shuttle service please register via the excel form.**

By public transportation:

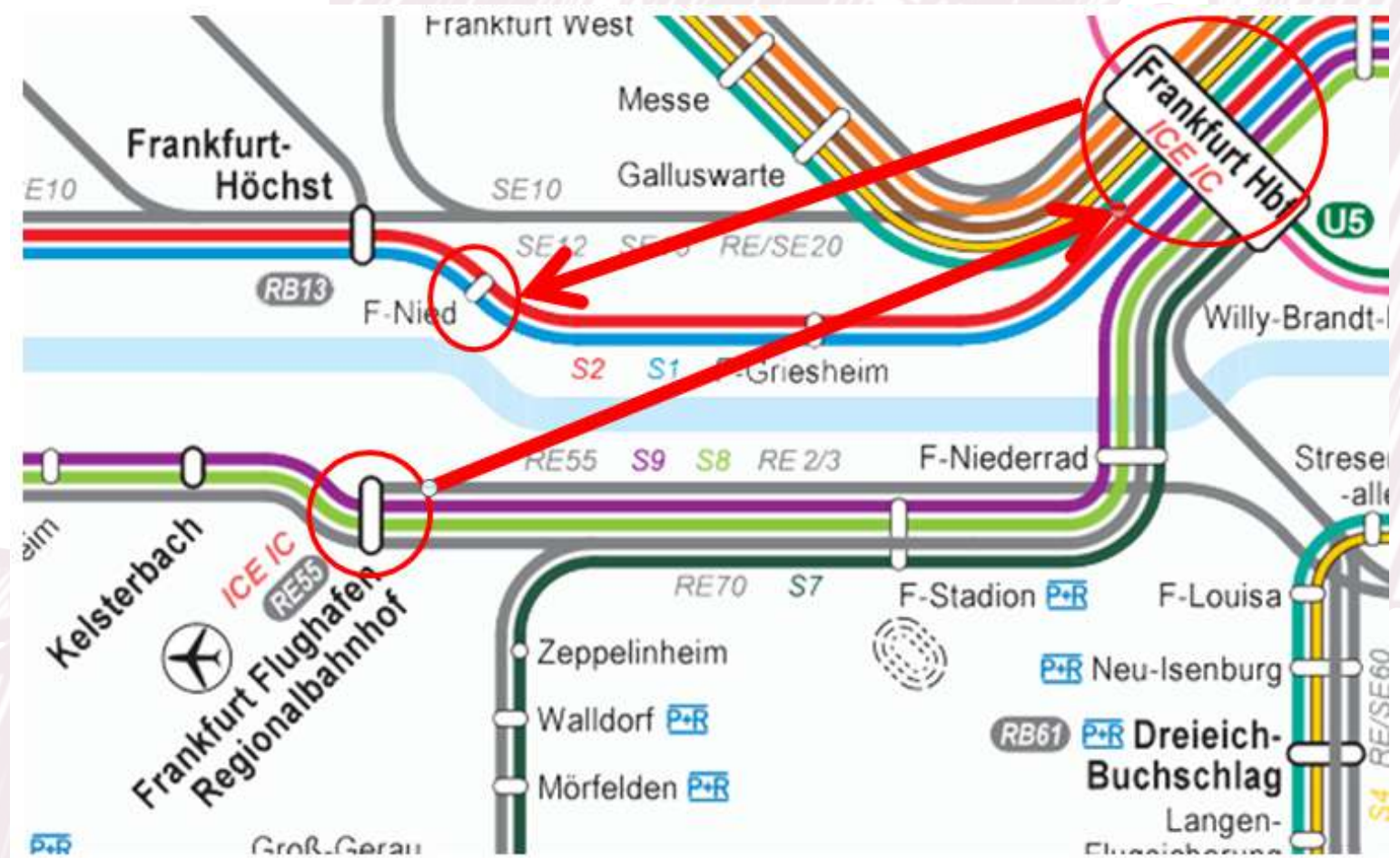


The sports centre is also in reach by public transportation which has two city trains - the S-Bahn and U-Bahn.

From Frankfurt/Main central station (*Hauptbahnhof*) there are two S-Bahn-lines leading to *Frankfurt Nied*:

1. S1 to Wiesbaden Hbf
2. S2 to Niedernhausen

Eligibility

Only members of Federations / Associations of the EVVF who has completed their financial duty with the EVVF are allowed to take part in the competition.

A category shall be eligible with the participation of at least 3 athletes / teams.

Accreditation

Each participant must send his / her ID photo to the Organising Committee for the issue of accreditation card. These cards will be issued to each participant on to team's arrival at the sports centre and should be carried at all time during the championship.

Referees

Referees will be appointed by the EVVF.

Accommodation and meals are to be (at least partially) covered by the EVVF.

Competition registration fees

The registration fee is 25 €/athlete/category. If the athlete competes in more than one category, the fee for each additional category is 10 €

Competition procedure (Drawing)

The draw will be held immediately after the delegations meeting under the control and observation of the EVVF. Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the drawing (a maximum of 2 delegates will be authorized).

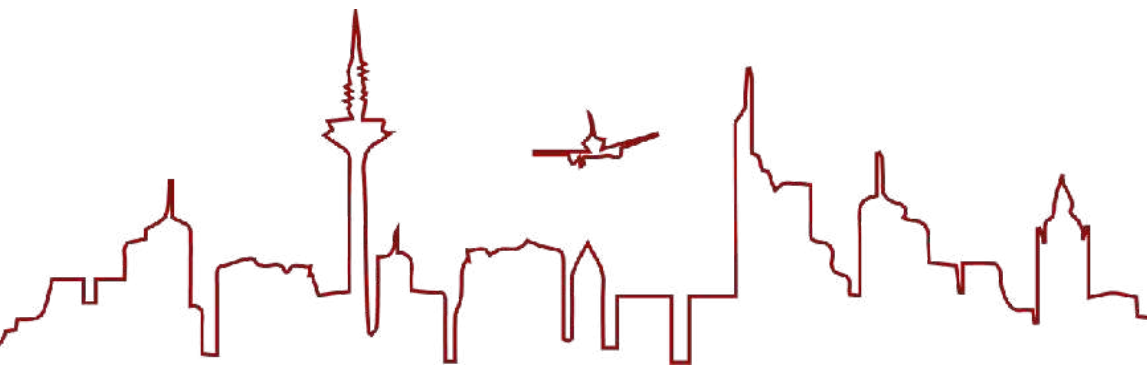

D.4. COMPETITORS ELIGIBILITY

Age

Group 1: 9 - 12 years old (year of birth 2010-2007)

Group 2: 13 - 15 years old (year of birth 2006-2004)

Group 3: 16 - 18 years old (year of birth 2003-2001)

We do not look at the age of the competitors but their year of birth (e.g. competitors who are 8 years old but born in 2010 are admitted to compete).

Nationality

The competitors must be of the same nationality as the National Federation, which enters them.

Gender

The female competitors may also have to undergo the Gender Control. Athletes are non-checking in case of having the gender certificate that is provided by mandated organisations.

Uniform

All Vovinam uniform must be in accordance with the EVVF regulations. All Vovinam uniforms shall have the name of the country only.

Belts

All competitors in Group 1 and 2 shall compete with a dark blue belt without stripes. Competitors in Group 3 shall compete with a yellow belt without stripes.

Health

All competitors must have a health certificate to ensure that they are eligible for competitions. The certificate must be submitted together with the national team's registration upon arrival.

Insurance

It is compulsory for all participants and members of delegations to have their own medical and personal trip insurance. The Organising Committee assume no liability or responsibility for the lack of insurance from participants and/or members of delegations. The Head of Teams have to sign the Terms of Responsibility and return it by mail to the Organising Committee before 22 September 2019.



D. COMPETITION REGULATIONS

D.5. COMPLAINTS & SANCTIONS

Only the head coach has the right to complain. The complaint must be submitted in form of an official letter and a fee of 150 €.

In case of complaining about human resource (athlete or referee), the form must be submitted to the Organising Committee before drawing. In case of a technical complaint, the form must be submitted to the Organising Committee within 10 minutes after the match.

The Organising Committee will consider and come to a decision about the case before the next competition takes place. The fee will only be repaid in the event of success for the claimant.

The penalty for not sending at least one referee to the championship is 300 €. This rule applies for the countries which have more than 50 members.

In case of any violation against the EVVF rules and regulations, the championship regulation or any misbehavior during competitions, including anti-doping codes or any involvement in a smear campaign or any attempt against the EVVF or German government, sanctions can be concluded by the Championship Organising Committee or EVVF leaders.

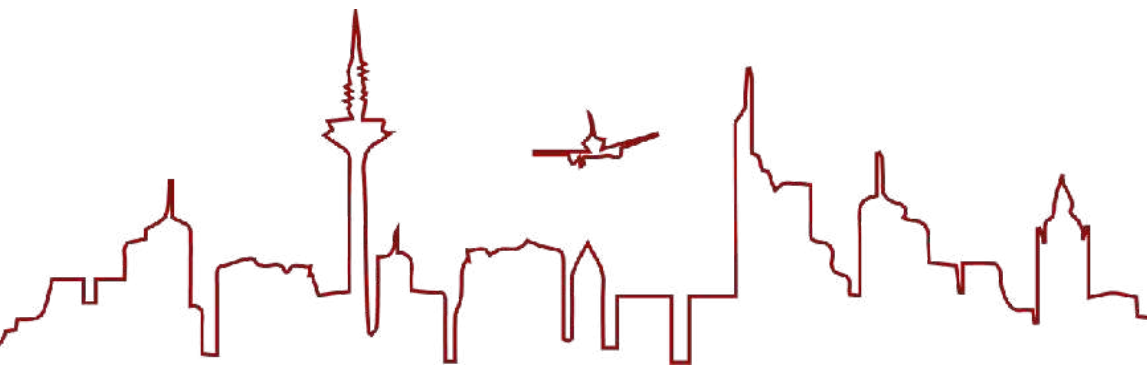
Athletes and referees may be suspended of right and / or duty due to any disqualification or misbehaviors against the mentioned rules / regulations.
